



Resolution in Support of a Plan for Reproductive Justice on Campus at the Graduate Center and CUNY

Adopted by the Doctoral and Graduate Students' Council (DGSC) on December 9th, 2022

WHEREAS, on June 24th, 2022, the Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade, the landmark case that guaranteed individuals the right to a safe abortion and bodily autonomy in the United States; and

WHEREAS, CUNY students, faculty, and staff have organized to defend the bodily autonomy around CUNY for Abortion Rights; and

WHEREAS, CUNY for Abortion Rights has sent Chancellor Felix Matos Rodriguez a list of petitions including reproductive rights support services that include, among other details, safe, free, and accessible abortion pills on demand at campus health services; and

WHEREAS, the Reproductive Justice Collective, a collective of youth and student organizers across New York, has worked with other universities on similar petitions, including Barnard College which [will provide pills to their students starting in Fall 2023](#).

WHEREAS a number of Graduate Center students also collaborate with the Reproductive Justice Collective. THEREFORE, LET IT BE

RESOLVED that the DGSC will join the [Petition of Support - CUNY/SUNY Medication Abortion on Campus created by the Reproductive Justice Collective](#); and

RESOLVED, that the DGSC demands the Graduate Center administration to provide access to abortion pills on campus.
