


1. In general, are you aware of the existence of Title IX at the Graduate Center, CUNY?




2. Have you ever experienced sexual misconduct (such as assault, harassment, or stalking) while attending the Graduate Center, CUNY?








Experience with Title IX

1. Were the procedures involved in reporting your case clearly explained to you? For example, were you informed ab...ures to be taken to protect yourself?




2. While reporting a case with Title IX, did you feel like you were treated fairly and decently?




Some commonly reported issues:

Several people reported feeling discredited, not taken seriously, or treated as potential suspects while trying to report their case of sexual misconduct.


3. Did you file a formal complaint?




4. After filing a formal complaint (if applicable) were you updated on the progress of your case in a timely man...u told what was going to happen next?




5. Were you offered any additional resources (counseling, temporary safety and/or relief measures)?

Several people noted that while their experience with the Title IX office was negative, they still believed that reporting cases of sexual misconduct is important (to have a record, better than to do nothing about it, etc).


Did not report to Title IX or associated offices

Some commonly reported reasons:

Fear of retaliation by the perpetrator, mistrust in the Title IX process, or being discouraged from complaining.

Some commonly reported reasons why people would NOT feel comfortable reporting:

Lack of clarity about the process, mistrust of the Title IX process, heard about bad experiences of others, fear of retaliation.

Other general comments:

Several people emphasized that Title IX processes should be made clearer and more widely advertised. Others commented that the current structure is inappropriate or insufficient to combat sexual misconduct, or seems to be more about protecting the institution than victims, or that it generally fails to provide support for victims and/or consequences for perpetrators (especially perpetrators in positions of power).
