- II. Elections
  - A. Co-chair for student affairs. Stephanie Domenici ran unopposed. 41 votes for. 2 abstentions.
  - B. Co-chair for Communications: Paul McBreen ran unopposed. 43 votes for.
  - C. Co-Chair for Business: Aleta Styers ran unopposed. 36 votes for with 2 abstentions.
  - D. Steering Committee: Celia Braxton, Eric Doviak, Camille Tipton, Moira Egan, Tomo Imamichi and Tina Lee elected.
  - E. Research Foundation Rep: Kallen Tsikalas elected.
  - F. USS Rep—alternate will be elected in the fall (attempted nomination of Rebecca Bucht but she was not present). David Golland ran unopposed: Unanimously elected with 34 votes.

- III. Discussion of Upcoming and Ongoing Issues
  - A. Health/Wellness Center and Health Insurance: Mandatory health insurance not coming. Wellness Center safe and administration looking for funding.
  - B. GC President and Transition: we must watch how administration looks for the new president. We need to make sure students are involved and that we form good relationships with new officials.
  - C. Need to keep up communication with the departments: use e-mail and talk up the website.
  - D. Want to continue our outreach to off-campus students. Some efforts have been made. Help from off-campus reps requested.
  - E. We have had to watch IR and the tech fee committee for how money has been spent. Tech fee committee members should be vigilant.
  - F. Tuition remission is being implemented.
  - G. Must continue to work with PSC-CUNY to mobilize adjuncts.
  - H. We have been trying to form a closer relationship with the University Student Senate and have been working with the undergrads on our issues. This will help build support for ours.
