Memorandum

To: Elliot Zupnick, Associate Dean

From: Gerald B. Scharfman, Chairman, Doctoral Students' Council

I am very pleased that President Rees has asked you to be "a representative of the administration" to the Doctoral Students' Council. Your interest in student affairs and student welfare will play no small part in the success of our organization.

As the Dean charged with the responsibility of liaison between the administration and the Doctoral Students' Council, it is to you that the following resolutions passed by the Steering Committee of the Council would be directed. At the direction of the Committee, therefore, I am submitting them for your consideration.

S.C./D.S.C. #1 4/10/70

RESOLVED, That all student activities fees not spent during this semester be carried over to the fall semester; and be it further

RESOLVED, That as of June, 1970, the disbursement of all student activities fees be under the control of the Doctoral Students' Council through its elected officers and representatives; and be it further

RESOLVED, That until such transfer of student activities fees to the Doctoral Students' Council be effected, the administration continue to supply the staff and materials necessary to help get the Council "off the ground."

EXPLANATION: To specifically implement the above resolution, the Steering Committee of the Doctoral Students' Council has directed me to request the following from the administration:

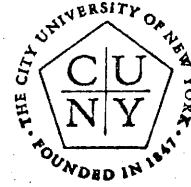
- 1- A permanent, fully-equipped office at the Graduate Center to reflect in size and appointments the position of the Doctoral Students' Council within the University Graduate Division.
- 2- A member of the President's staff to serve on a day to day basis as operational liaison between the Doctoral Students' Council and the administration.
- 3- A secretary.

- 4- Office materials, including stationary with the letterhead of the Doctoral Students' Council, two telephones, two typewriters and all other material support and administrative privileges necessary for running an effective organization.

S.C./D.S.C. #2 4/10/70

WHEREAS, All students in doctoral programs are matriculated at the Graduate Division of the City University of New York, and

WHEREAS, The students of the Graduate Division have voted in referendum to establish the Doctoral Students' Council as their representative organization, and

WHEREAS, It is the traditional right of student organizations at the City University of New York to control the student activities fees of their constituents; be it

RESOLVED, That all student activities fees paid by doctoral students revert to the control of the Doctoral Students' Council of the Graduate Division of the City University of New York, including student activities fees formerly paid to the local colleges; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the administration take the necessary steps to effect the transfer of all student activities fees to the Doctoral Students' Council as of registration for summer courses in June, 1970.

S.C./D.S.C. #3 4/10/70

RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Doctoral Students' Council, or another executive officer designated by him, sit at all meetings of the President's Cabinet to represent the views of the Council to the administration and participate in all matters bearing on the interests of the students; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the agenda for all meetings of the President's Cabinet be transmitted to the Chairman of the Doctoral Students' Council prior to each meeting.
